Our park has been thoughtfully designed to ensure that guests with special needs, sensory sensitivities, and diverse abilities can explore, play, and relax with dignity and joy. From quiet zones to specialized accommodations, inclusivity is woven into the fabric of our destination.

Sensory-Friendly Design

We understand that for many of our guests, the environment is just as important as the activity. We have integrated "sensory things" throughout the park to create a supportive landscape for our neurodiverse visitors.

- **Sensory Gardens:** Tucked away from the high-energy areas of the park, our sensory gardens are sanctuaries of calm. These curated spaces feature plants chosen for their tactile properties, soothing scents, and gentle sounds, allowing guests to ground themselves in nature without becoming overwhelmed.
- **Dedicated Sensory Trails:** While some guests seek the thrill of a rugged hike, others need a more predictable experience. Our sensory trails are clearly marked and feature interactive stations—such as musical wooden chimes, texture walls, and visual tracking games—that encourage engagement at the guest's own pace.
- **Low-Sensory Zones:** We have designated specific "Quiet Zones" in each spoke where loud noises and bright lights are minimized. These areas provide a safe retreat for guests who may need to decompress after a day of excitement.

Adaptive Accommodations

Our commitment to accessibility extends to where you sleep. We offer specialized units within our cabins, RV sites, and tent sites designed specifically for guests with special needs.

- **Sensory-Adapted Cabins:** Select cabins are equipped with adjustable lighting (dimnable and soft-hue options), sound-dampening insulation, and simplified layouts to reduce visual clutter and anxiety.
- **Accessible RV & Tent Sites:** These sites are located on flat, paved or hard-packed terrain to accommodate mobility devices. They are strategically positioned close to ADA-compliant bathhouses and far from high-traffic areas to ensure privacy and ease of access.

Meet Nova the Firefly

Navigating a large park can be daunting, but our guests never have to do it alone. Meet **Nova the Firefly**, our official mascot and guide for inclusivity.

- **Nova's Wayfinding:** Wherever you see Nova's glowing symbol on a map or trail marker, you know you are entering an accessible or sensory-friendly area. Nova helps families quickly identify safe spaces, accessible restrooms, and sensory gardens.
- **Nova's Story Time:** Nova hosts special storytelling sessions and meet-and-greets designed for children with sensory processing differences. These events are kept small, quiet, and interactive, ensuring every child feels seen and included.
- **The "Glow" Badge system:** Guests can follow Nova's tracks to earn special inclusivity badges in their passports, celebrating kindness, understanding, and the unique ways we all experience the world.
