Your Basecamp for Adventure: Safe, Spacious, and Organized

To preserve the tranquility and safety of our guest spokes, Celestial Falls Agripark operates a designated "Trailer-Free Zone" beyond our main entrance. Our expansive 15-acre Staging Area serves as the logistical heartbeat for all large rigs, ensuring that our campground roads remain quiet, uncluttered, and safe for pedestrians and children. This facility is secured 24/7 and is the mandatory parking zone for all haulers.

Dedicated Staging Zones

We understand that different adventures require different gear. To streamline your arrival, our 15-acre lot is divided into two distinct, purpose-built sections.

- **ATV & OHV Hauler Zone:** This section features extra-wide pull-through lanes designed to accommodate toy haulers and large flatbed trailers. It includes loading ramps and wash-down stations to help you prep your vehicles before and after your ride.
- **Equestrian Transport Zone:** A dedicated area specifically for horse trailers and livestock trucks. This quiet zone is situated away from the engine noise of the ATV section to keep animals calm during unloading. It features hitching posts and water access for your stock.

The "No Trailer" Policy & Security Station

The Security Station acts as the gatekeeper to the inner park. Please be advised of the following traffic rules designed to enhance your stay.

- **Mandatory Drop-Off:** All trailers—whether for boats, horses, or ATVs—must be unhooked and parked in their respective Staging Zone. **No trailers are permitted past the Security Station** or into the accommodation spokes.
- **Secure Storage:** The staging area is monitored by security cameras and patrolled by our staff, giving you peace of mind that your equipment is safe while you enjoy the comforts of your cabin or campsite.
- **Check-In Protocol:** Upon arrival, guests with trailers will be directed to the Staging Area first to unhook before proceeding to the Check-In Office or their campsite.

Ride-In / Ride-Out Logistics

Once your equipment is unloaded, we have specific pathways to get you to your adventure.

ATV & OHV Guests

- **Arrival Transport:** You are permitted to ride your ATV/UTV from the Staging Area directly to your assigned campsite or cabin to unload your personal gear.
- **Trail Access Rule:** Once at your site, ATVs are to be used strictly for accessing the trailheads. Joyriding within the spokes or around the Main Hub is prohibited to reduce noise and dust. From your site, you proceed directly to the designated trail access points.

Equestrian Guests

- **Barn Transfer:** Horses may be ridden or walked from the Equestrian Staging Zone directly to the Stables/Barn area for boarding or tacking up.
- **Trail Access Rule:** From the Barn, all equestrian traffic is routed directly to the specific horse trailheads (e.g., *Whispering Pines* or *Boone's Bridle Path*). Horses are not permitted in the accommodation spokes, playgrounds, or Main Hub grassy areas.
